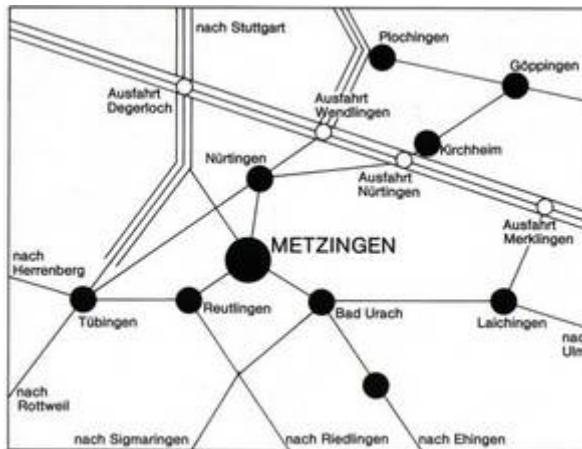
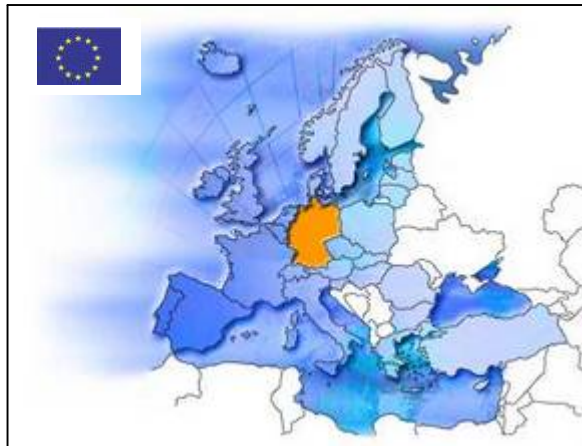

- Introduction of Compulsory Daytime Education
- Appointment of the first full time vocational teacher Karl Kirchenmaier
- Education in the old school building - later called Hindenburgschule, today 7-Keltern-Schule, since 1928 first own building at Lindenplatz
- 120 students, 3 classes
- 6 Vocational Departments: Metal, Construction, Arts and Crafts, Tanning, Glovers, Merchants
- 7 hours per week in the Dual System per student
- 3 classrooms, no workshops yet

- Compulsory Education in the Dual System and full time schooling
- 64 full time teachers
- own school buildings in Max-Eyth-Street (erected 1974, 1985 and 1995)
- 1,100 students, 56 classes
- 4 Vocational Departments: Metal, Automobile, Professional Cleaning, Fashion Design
- 13 hours/week in the Dual System per student
- 28 classrooms, 19 workshops
